# SWIMMING IRON

2 Kings 6:1-7  
aka: When God Cared About A  
Borrowed Tool

It wasn't a huge, headline-making miracle. No thunder, no fire, no armies. Just a guy swinging an ax, losing his grip, and watching the iron head sink straight to the bottom of the river.

Panic set in — it wasn't even his ax. It was borrowed. A small thing, maybe, but a big deal to him. So Elisha did something unexpected. He threw a stick into the water, and the iron floated to the surface. "The iron swam." No explanation. No spectacle. Just a quiet reminder that nothing is too small for God to notice.

Swimming Iron is about the kind of care that reaches into your everyday moments; the forgotten things, the broken things, the heavy things that feel like they've sunk for good.

Because with God, even the things that seem lost to the deep still have a way of rising again.
